Your First Visit Visiting any church for the very first time can be an intimidating experience. Where to go? What to wear? What's here for my kids? What to expect? 1. How do I get there?
  - a. We are located at 5266 Wilcox Rd. in Whitesboro in a lovely neighborhood.
2. What's on the schedule?
  - a. Sunday school begins at 10am with a small class for every age group. Light refreshments are offered after Sunday school in the downstairs fellowship area. This is followed by the main Sunday service at 11am. We enjoy old fashioned congregational hymns as well as encouraging music performed by the adult choir. The music is always followed by a clear, helpful and challenging Bible message from Pastor McCoy. A King James Bible is provided in the pew rack. The service is a little over one hour in length.
3. What's here for my kids?
  - a. From nursery age to college age, we have something for every age! For children 3 and under, we provide a clean, caring and safe nursery during every service. The nursery is located directly behind the main auditorium, where your little ones will be close to you. Children 4 and older have fun Sunday school classes formatted just for them. 4. How should I dress?
  - a. There is not a dress code for members or guests of Harts Hill Baptist Church. Our ministry leaders and many of our church family dress in more traditional "Sunday" dress; however, our main goal is that you feel welcome and comfortable on your visit here at Harts Hill!
5. Am I expected to participate in the offering?
  - a. No. We don't invite you to Harts Hill Baptist Church for your offering. We want our service to be a gift to you. We hope you will find in this place a warm family spirit, truth from God's Word, and a place where you can grow in God's grace. Please don't feel you have to participate in the offering as a guest.

6. Are there services at other times?

- a. Yes. We have a Sunday evening service that is very different than the Sunday morning service. Starting at 7pm, we enjoy songs and testimonies and another helpful sermon from the Bible. We also meet Wednesday evenings at 7pm for Bible Study and Prayer. If you can't be our guest on Sunday morning, we hope you'll join us during another service time.
